AGM

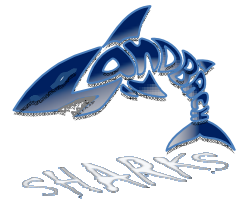
The meeting agendas, accounts, nominations on are all on the tables.

2. **Minutes of last AGM – approval**

Mark Davies (club member) pointed out (via email) that according to our constitution, all members should receive the agenda, nominations and accounts at least 14 days before the AGM. This will be followed for next years AGM, and the committee apologised for the oversight.

3. **Treasurers Report**

Richard Slater presented the treasurers report. . RS explained difference in accounts from 2009-10 and 2010-11. Over that time, there has been a loss for 2011 £2180.55. Fees have been increased to help keep club in sound financial state. Reasons for losses include closure of MMU facility, costs for use of boy's school and lifeguards. It was hoped that some funds would be available from Cheshire East to help Sharkies.



4. Chairman - Review of year

It was a tough start to year with the closing of the MMU pool.

This presented us with many challenges including lack of pool time, and a 25% increase in pool hire costs.

Accordingly, the committee were forced to increase costs, which was not an ideal situation, but other local clubs are suffering similar problems.

We still want more pool time including mornings, but we will either have to up costs or recruit more swimmers

Coaching Staff

We have a dedicated teaching and coaching staff lead by Carolyn

Carolyn spends many hours at the pools, pestering you all to volunteer as coaches and poolside helpers. In the absence of a volunteer, she is also acting as Team Manager, helping husband Terry with individual gala entries.

Matt, who used to coach on Friday evenings, moved to Didsbury. Dave Goddard is still with us and other coaches are Sarah Goddard (level 1), Helen Wilson (level 2), David Trussler and Simon Geary. We also have a newly qualified teacher Sam Peart and Sister Sarah (level 1) helping, Juliet Richards (*Level 1*) and Robert Hainsworth (level 1) Sharkies coaches Audrey Waddilove (Swim NW AWARD), JohnTohill (*level 1*), Grace Henderson, Phil Davey and Lauren. Rosie Walsh is also helping whilst she is unable to swim because of injury.

It's great to see youngsters getting qualifications and helping.

Anthony Jevons is living away much of the time, and spends less time poolside but thanks for many years help.

I hope I haven't missed anyone but a huge thanks to all of you – without your volunteering, there would be no club.

It's good to see younger swimmers helping on poolside – we hope to run a poolside helpers course in the autumn.

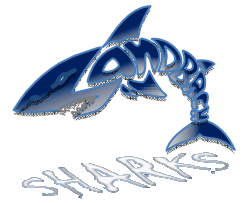
We still need volunteers at all levels so we can move onwards and upwards- willing helpers on pool side to take or update qualifications and get involved on a regular basis.

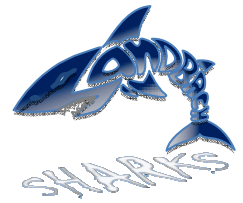
Thanks to the commitment of all swimmers / volunteers who run club.
